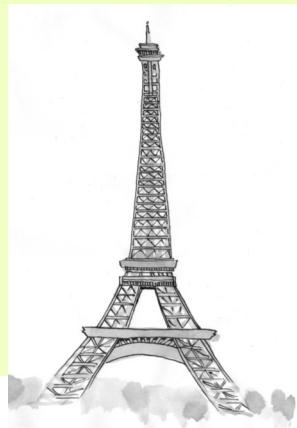

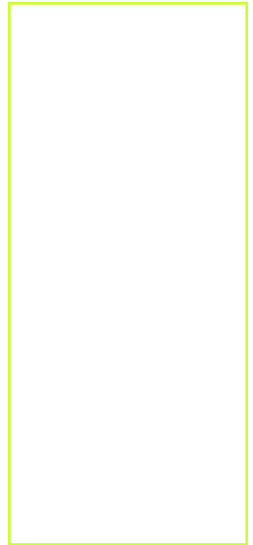
Varsity Golf

B-Team Softball

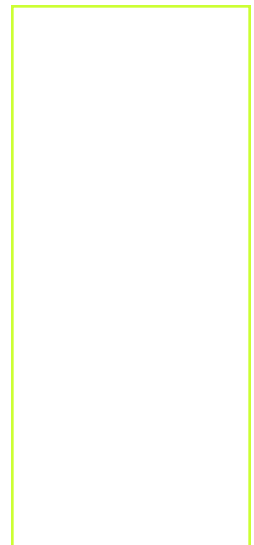

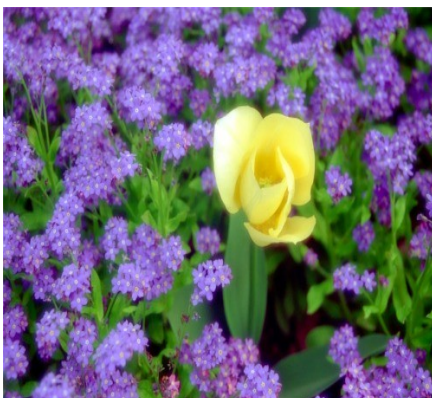
